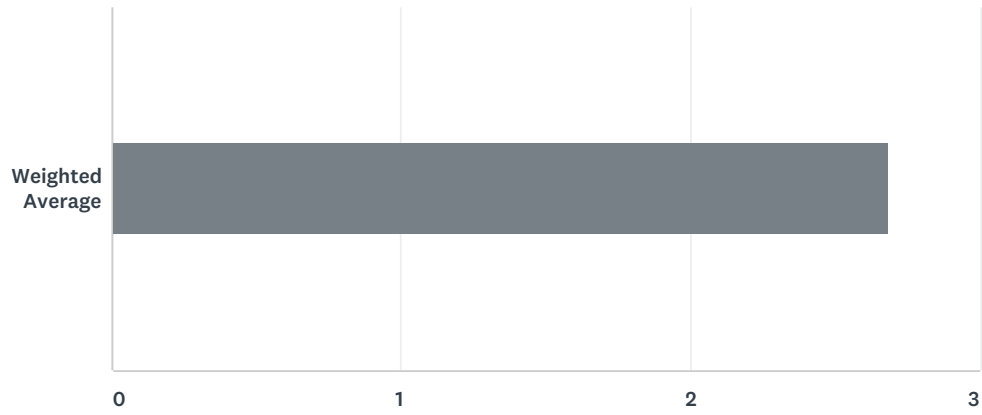

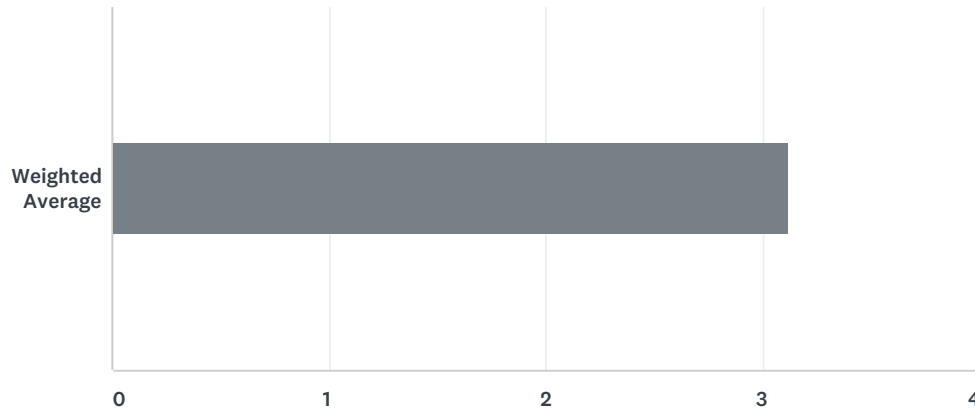

### Q3 Overall how valuable was today's Lunch & Learn session for you & your jurisdiction?

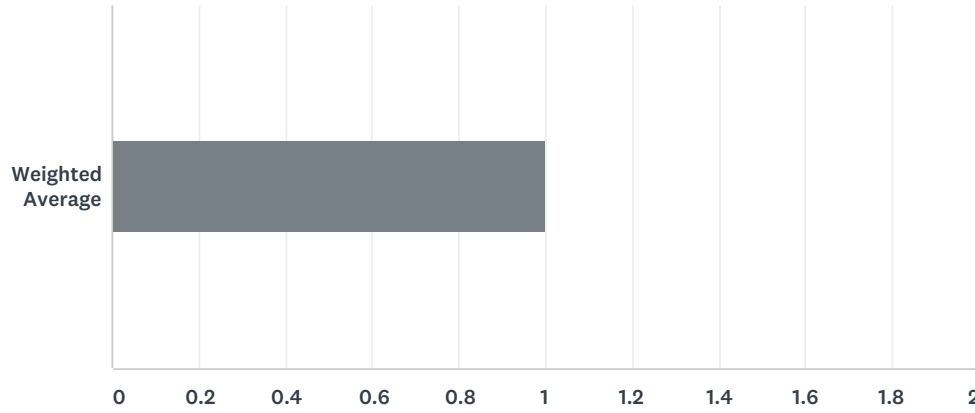

## Q4 Should ECC continue to host this event annually?

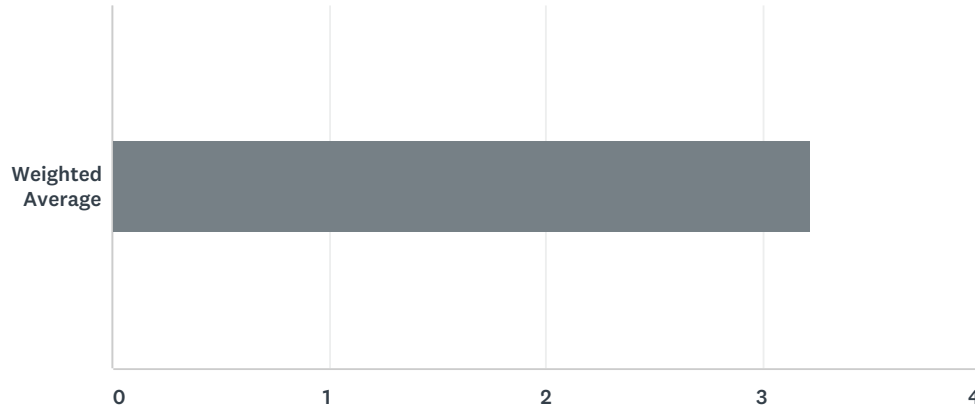

## Q5 How would you score the meeting facility accommodations?

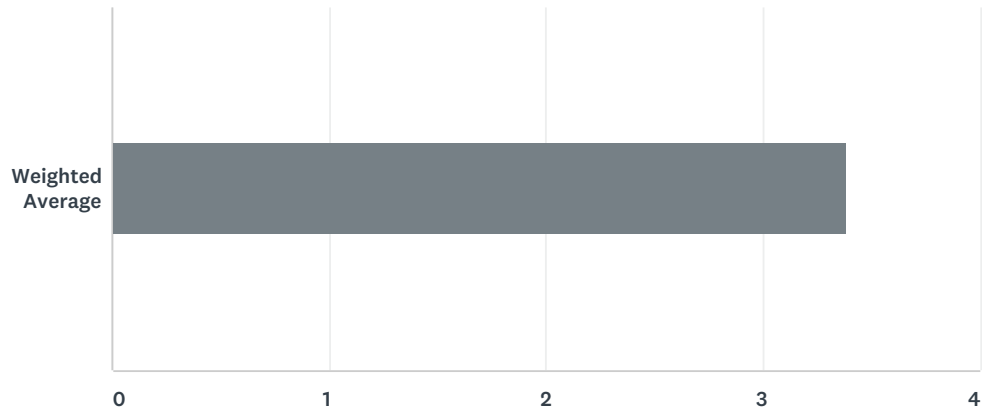

## Q6 How would you score the meal & setup?

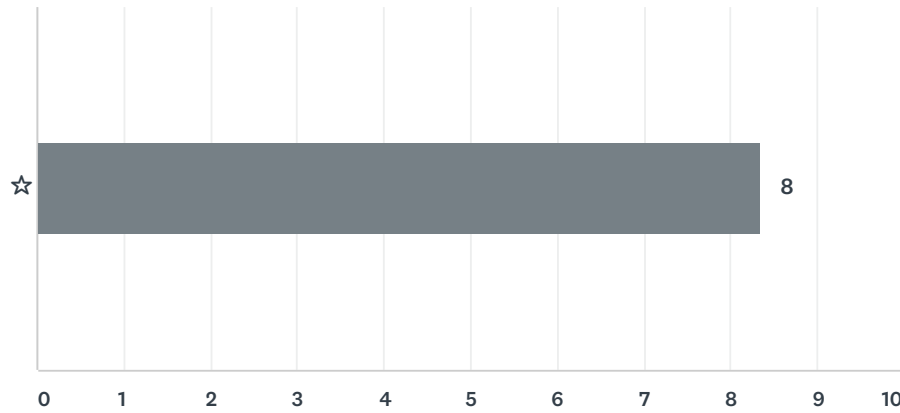
